IDENTIFICATION CARDS TO BE ISSUED!

Beginning December 2014, the American Institute in Taiwan (AIT) will begin issuing new identification cards with the approval of the U.S. Department of State.


These identification cards are issued to employees and family members of the Taipei Economic and Cultural Representative Office (TECRO) in the Washington Metropolitan area, and the Taipei Economic and Cultural Offices (TECOs) located throughout the United States.

The American Institute in Taiwan identification cards will incorporate the same state of the art features as the Department of State identification cards which enhance its security and vastly reduce the risk of counterfeiting.






TECRO FAMILY MEMBER
