Dear Mrs. Marcos:

The provisions of Section 1185(a)(1) of Title 8 of the United States Code make it unlawful for any alien to depart the United States unless such departure is in conformity with the rules and regulations issued under that Section. I now have reason to believe that you intend to depart from the United States in a manner which would be prejudicial to the interests of the United States. I further have reason to believe that your departure from the United States would fall within Part 215.3 of Title 8 of the Code of Federal Regulations (copy attached), and is therefore prohibited. Consequently, in accordance with the authority vested in me under 8 C.F.R. 215.2(a) (copy attached), you are hereby ordered that you shall not depart the United States until such time as this order is revoked.

In conformity with 8 C.F.R. 215.4, you have a right to a hearing before a special inquiry officer (immigration judge) regarding this order. A copy of the regulations describing the hearing process and your entitlement to representation during that process is attached.

Any such request for a hearing must be received by the undersigned at 395 Ala Moana Boulevard, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813. If you do not make a timely request for such a hearing, this order shall become final fifteen (15) days from the date of service upon you.
