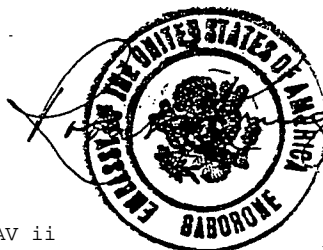
The Embassy of the United States of America presents its compliments to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Botswana, and has the honor to refer to the Ministry's note 1/99 E 14/1 XXXIX(56)Ag.C2 of January 28, 1999 concerning the agreement between our governments as related to the employment of staff dependents at our respective diplomatic missions, signed at Gaborone on June 15, 1984 (the "Agreement").

The Embassy proposes that the agreement be amended by deleting Article V. If the foregoing proposal is acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Botswana, the Embassy of the United States of America further proposes that this note and the Ministry's note in reply shall constitute an amendment to the Agreement which shall enter into force on the date of the Ministry's reply note.
